After successful shows in Paris, India, and Bangladesh, Monica Jahan Bose comes to Miami Beach with fresh paintings exploring love, female sexuality, and human connection in our complicated world. Her work simultaneously speaks about her own life and about global social and political issues. These mixed-media paintings chart out a personal symbolic language, reflecting the artist's diverse professional background and heritage. A South Asian-American, Bose comes from a family of Hindus and Muslims split between Bangladesh and India. She studied art at Wesleyan University, the University of California at Berkeley, and at Shantiniketan, India, and has a law degree from Columbia University. She was one of twelve emerging painters chosen for this year's prestigious Prix Marin exhibition in Paris.
