The rally website is also set out above and has been up and running since the 29 March 2013. On the rally website you can see the entry form, details of accommodation available and preliminary back ground information. This is just the start. We shall be adding to the website progressively in the lead up to the rally with details of activities, area attractions, sponsorship and list of sponsors, competitions, venues and activities etc all at a click onto the website. If you also need help in the traditional way you can phone or mail and we shall be happy to help with information.

In addition to myself and Laury we have an enthusiastic team of people from Albury/Wodonga all performing various tasks to ensure the rally is successfully run and that people have an enjoyable and memorable time at the 17th National Rally – the first two state rally ever held.

Some people have already asked about venues and accommodation. Whilst we have already made preliminary bookings in both Albury and Wodonga for dinners and functions, entrants can assume that there will be activities in both states, Victoria and NSW, and should bear this in mind when making accommodation arrangements. Other than the Sunday run, we expect that registration, concourse and assembly points for runs will be unlikely to be more than about 10km distance apart so that people can plan their accommodation.

On the website you will see a list of accommodation options including units, motels, cabins, caravan parks etc that provide a wide range of accommodation options. We know that people who have previously attended the Mighty Morrie Muster in Albury have preferred places to stay and we have tried to include those on the list where possible.

We haven't at this stage planned any activities before or after the rally but Albury Wodonga is close to the Rutherglen/Milawa wine and gourmet food regions and we intend supplying lots of information on those places and activities available in the months leading up to the rally. If you have enjoyed the Mighty Morrie Muster in the past, we would love to have you as our guests at the 17th National Rally. We at Albury Wodonga love to see our friends and guests back to enjoy your friendship and we are excited at the prospect of having so many old and new friends back to join us

and share in the fun of the next National Rally.

In the next Bulletin we intend dealing with much more detail on the "nuts and bolts" of the rally

including name tags with car photos, more detailed information on the website, more specific

information about bookings and all you need to know to ensure the rally is a success and you are kept

fully informed.

We shall also be sending off separately at this stage receipts to those who have already registered

with confirmation of rally entry numbers. Photo name tags will come down the track. Thanks for

your interest and we look forward to seeing you at Easter 2015.
