MsP=Measured picot

using picot gauge.

RW =Reverse Work (up to down)

TW=Turn Work (side to side)

lj =lock join

+ =join

p,- =picot

SS =Switch Shuttles

SLT =Shoe lace trick

CTM= Continuous Thread Method

SKILL LEVEL = PROFICIENT BEGINNER/INTERMEDIATE

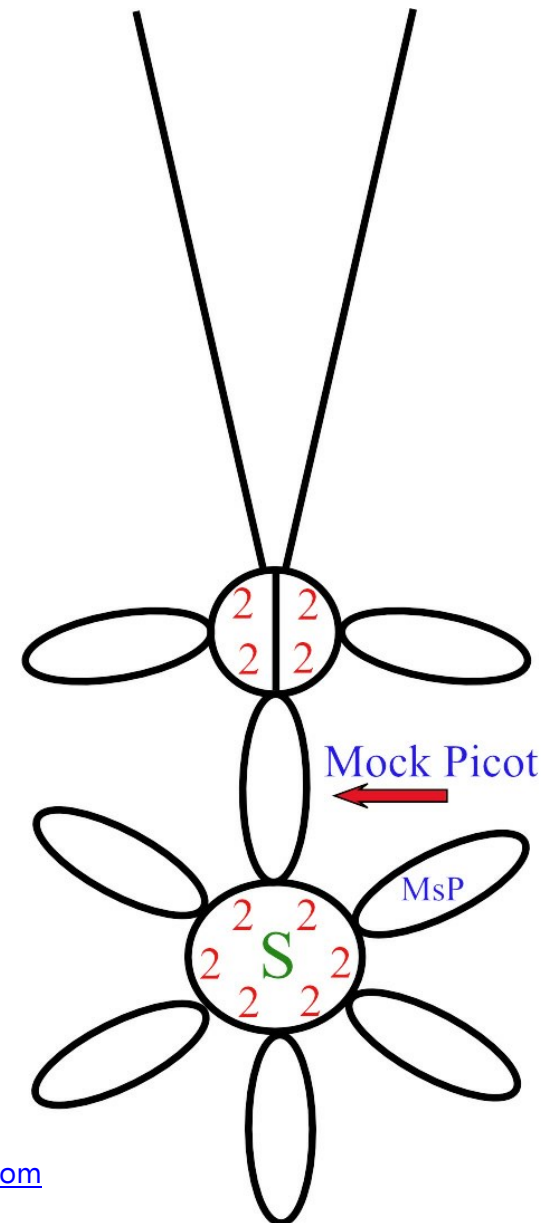
YOU WILL NEED:

2 shuttles, 1 color CTM size 20 thread

Picot Gauge = 1/2inch or 1 centimeter.

Day One

- R 2 (MsP using picot gauge) 2 (X5)
- Climb out with a mock picot making sure it is the same length as previous picots.
- SR 2 MsP 2/2 MsP 2



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
