WASHINGTON (DC) – Attorney Malik Z. Shabazz, President of Black Lawyers for Justice and Joann Dingle-Hall, wife of Selwyn Aubrey Hall will hold a news conference to object to the shooting and killing of Selwyn Aubrey Hall on April 26, 2017, by Jacksonville Sheriff Ryan L. McGee. Sheriffs have erroneously claimed that Mr. Hall violently resisted arrest and attempted to grab the officer's Taser.

SUPPORT RALLY – 6 pm: Sponsored by The Justice League President Bobby Worthy and James Muhammad of the Black Educators for Justice, a support rally for the Hall family will feature activists and locals who are fed up with police brutality. The rally will be held at Unity Missionary Baptist Church.

Attorney Malik Z. Shabazz says: *"Our investigation up to this point leads us to believe that the officers are lying and that deadly force was not necessary. Mr. Hall did not present a deadly threat to the officers and we are challenging the Sheriff Department's side of the story."* Mr. Shabazz is a nationally known and respected attorney, organizer and advocate for justice.
