They can be read on smart phones, tablets, eBook readers, and computers. The directors of CBM agreed to have some of CBM's books converted to this format and distributed worldwide.

Currently one CBM book is available this way, Josiah - Chain Breaker. The next book, Groping for God, will be available in the next days or weeks. Other books are being prepared, including Living Your Dreams and **Onesimus – Transformed.** They are being distributed through the major worldwide retailers of eBooks: Apple, Amazon, Nook, Kobo and others.
