






# 'COBRA STICH' PARACORD BRACELET



You need approx 2 meters of cord and a side release clip  
(varies depending on wrist size and cord thickness - experiment)

When you get to the end of the bracelet cut off the spare cord  
and melt the ends into the bracelet to stop it unravelling. (use  
a match, lighter or ideally a soldering iron.)

**WHY make one?...** In an emergency 2 meters of cord can  
be a new shoe lace, repair a bag or rucksack, tie  
equipment together, be pulled apart into thin fibres for  
fishing line or....
