Monica Jahan Bose's work charts out a personal language that blends her bicultural identity and diverse experiences. Her vibrant works contain multi-faceted messages about the joys and contradictions in our contemporary world. Using symbolic objects from East and West and text in Bengali and English, she creates thought-provoking yet beautiful paintings and fabric installations.

Monica Jahan Bose studied art at Wesleyan University, the University of California at Berkeley, and at Santiniketan, India. She studied law at Columbia University. She has exhibited her work in Bangladesh, France, India, Japan, and the US. Last year, she was one of 12 artists invited to participate in the prestigious Prix Marin Exhibition, an annual exhibition showcasing emerging painters in Paris.
