

# Oxford, Ohio train station

**For the first time in 50 years** Oxford, OH is poised to gain a train station on Amtrak's "*Cardinal*" route that passes right through town. Amtrak OK'd the city for a station stop after a recent study showed strong ridership potential to/from Chicago, the East Coast, plus active sports sites in West Virginia. Now \$1 million must to be found to build a station. Here's why...

## **Car-free connection to Chicago**

A station in the heart of Oxford offers a car-free link to Miami University's 2nd-largest student market (SW Ohio is #1) as well as to O'Hare International Airport used by international students who expect rail links to major universities.

## **Provides a rail link to Cincinnati**

The link to Cincinnati will only get better with faster and more frequent rail services including a daily *Cardinal* and extending Chicago-Indy *Hoosier* trains to SW Ohio.
