To think about

- What comes first for you? What you prioritize often has the greatest power and impact in your life.
- We don't often see our own significance for ourselves so ask others – ask people to pray and prophesy over you about your life.
- Take some time to look back and see if you can trace the hand of God in your life over years and encourage yourself in that.

To think about

- What treasures are you prioritising?
- If someone were to look for your treasure where would that show your heart is?
- What possessions that you own possess you? Heavenly ones or earthly ones?

3. Eyes full of light – v 22-23

To think about

- Jesus doesn't want us looking at dark things when there is so much more to see in the light! Where have you been looking recently?
- Do you need to do some turning around from what you have been giving your time and attention to?
