as nothing before him, they are accounted by him as less than nothing and emptiness" (40:17).

When genocide occurs without a second thought then God puts that nation under His judgment because God is the Author of Life and only He has the right to take human life. Where is this genocide taking place in America? Every single year there are about one million abortions in this country. Since Roe v Wade became law, almost fifty seven million babies have died in their mother's womb. In what used to be the safest place on earth has now become one of the deadliest. Do we really believe that God will look the other way when this genocide taking place in America goes on year after year? The answer seems obvious...no, He will not.

We have already seen that God abhors violence and so we know that abortion will bring God's judgment upon a nation but what are some of the other things that happen where God will surely judge a nation? Isaiah 2:6-12 clearly reveals what constitutes reasonable grounds for God bringing judgment on a nation:

"For you have rejected your people, the house of Jacob, because they are full of things from the east and of fortune-tellers like the Philistines... Their land is filled with silver and gold, and there is no end to their treasures... their land is filled with horses, and there is no end to their chariots... Their land is filled with idols; they bow down to the work of their hands... The haughty looks of man shall be brought low, and the lofty pride of men shall

be humbled... For the Lord of hosts has a day against all that is proud and lofty, against all that is lifted up—and it shall be brought low."

Notice that the land is full of horses and chariots which today might be cars and truck. The land is full of fortune-tellers today which are an abomination to God. They have their own idols and these idols might not be carved images but they are idols nonetheless. These idols might be money, positions of power, family, status, music, Hollywood, the Internet, and most of all, our own selves. These nations that God judges are also full of people who are full of pride and instead of humbling themselves, they are proud and lofty. Does this nation sound familiar? God has promised to judge nations such as these.

What did God do to these nations that did such things? He "scattered them among the nations, and they were dispersed through the countries. In accordance with their ways and their deeds I judged them" (Exodus 36:19). Could this happen to America? Yes! It might be a financial captivity because the U.S. is already in such heavy indebtedness to other nations that we are really "slave to the borrower" (Prov 22:7). This judgment could be where "people will die of the plague or perish by famine [and/or] fall by the sword [and be] scattered] to the winds and [be] pursued with drawn sword" (Ezekiel 5:12) and He may "hand them over to their enemies" (Ezekiel 39:23).


Will God's Judgement come upon the USA?

A possible Yellowstone volcano eruption in 2014 has some people pointing to how animals have been spotted fleeing the national park in recent days.

In a related report by *The Inquisitr*, it's claimed that the recent Yellowstone earthquakes won't trigger a volcano, but scientists have acknowledged that if a Yellowstone volcano were to erupt the resulting super-volcano could kill everyone in the United States: "The Yellowstone volcano erupting could release enough magma and ash to bury whole cities underneath kilometres of destruction. The good news is that the super-volcano at Yellowstone isn't in danger of exploding any time soon. The last time it occurred was before the dawn of civilization. While it's believed stopping an eruption is impossible, researchers say they should be able to predict an eruption by monitoring the pressure of underground magma."

The recent earthquakes only just made the

news but the entire area has been rumbling for over a week. Charts from the USGS show that earthquakes higher than 3.0 magnitude have been occurring off and on for multiple days and all of them have been coming from the region of the Yellowstone magma chamber, which, according to ground-penetrating radar, extends as far west as the Oregon state line.



One **website** is even trying to make Yellowstone earthquake predictions, claiming they will increase in number and magnitude.

"The heavy earthquake activity along the West Coast of the United States, over the past few weeks, has now translated in the craton displacement that we were expecting. The earthquakes inside the magma chamber at Yellowstone, and the earthquakes now occurring at dormant volcanic chains along South / Central California, mean we can expect further activity in the near term to INCREASE. The increase in activity along the edge of the craton will continue into the near term future due to the overall Pacific displacement occurring internationally."

In general, most academics agree that predicting earthquakes is difficult to impossible, although it's possible to analyse areas of the world to determine where the most damage might occur some time down the road. Aftershocks can also be somewhat predicted by considering basic plate tectonics.

The good news is that scientists are monitoring the Yellowstone magma chamber and, last we checked, no one was overly concerned about the possibility of a Yellowstone volcano eruption. The bad news is that they admit that "once you get enough melt, you can start an eruption just like that." What do you think about the conspiracy theories suggesting the USGS is trying to hide the bad news about the Yellowstone earthquakes?

Why would God judge America?

A number of facts would tend to make that more than a rhetorical or philosophical question. Consider:

- Homicide and incarceration highest of any industrialized nation. Ten times that of Japan, Sweden, Ireland, and the Netherlands.
- Crime increased by 371% since 1960, with Juvenile Crime up 920% since 1985, the highest in the world.
- Divorce quadrupled in the last 30 years, making the U.S. the world leader.
- Teenage pregnancies also quadrupled in the last 30 years (more than a million a year) making the US the Western World leader.

- Voluntary abortion leader in the world.
- Illegal drug use leader of the world.
- Illiteracy world leader, with National Educational Standards among the lowest in the world.
- Churches and TV evangelists preaching false doctrines and flirting with the Roman Catholic Church
- God and bibles have been taken out off schools, public buildings, hotels, hospitals and military.
- The government promotes Islam and persecutes Christians wherever it is possible.
- The government does not support Israel like before but gives money to its enemies.
- The whole nation is turning away from God and has reached a time of no return.

What does God say about this?

The Bible is clear that God is the Judge of all nations but just because He hasn't judged a nation doesn't mean that He won't. Clearly, God is over all the earth and this includes all nations as Psalm 82:9 says

"O God, judge the earth; for you shall inherit all the nations!" Eventually "He will execute judgment among the nations, filling them with corpses; he will shatter chiefs over the wide earth" (Psalm 110:6).

When compared to God, the nations are not only nothing, but they are less than nothing as Isaiah the prophet wrote "All the nations are
