Rule of the Week

14.03 Sideline area. Prior to the kick, no participants (or spectators) may be in the sideline area except for the kicker, the catcher, Referees and designated base coaches. After the kick, fielders and base runners in the process of playing the game may also occupy the sideline area (see Rule 1.01e).

The first infraction of this rule will result in a warning to the team that caused the infraction. The second and each subsequent infraction will result in an out for the next kicker in the written scorebook kicking order on the team that caused the infraction.


