We are in receipt of your e-mail of February 18, 2014, in which you posed certain arguments and questions concerning OCR's request for additional information regarding the post-secondary Title IX athletics complaints that you recently filed in this region. OCR's responses follow:

Part A

OCR is aware of this case law. It does not alter the case processing determinations made in this case.

Part B

Question 1: Please be advised that we cannot respond to your request because you were not a party to the complaints that you cite.

Questions 2-5: These questions relate to the procedures that OCR has established for evaluating complaints set forth in Section 108 of its *Case Processing Manual*. In our letter to you dated February 18, 2014, OCR requested that you provide additional information necessary for OCR to complete its evaluation of the 121 complaints that you filed in OCR's San Francisco regional office. Consistent with OCR's Case Processing Manual, at Section 108, the letter explained that you had not provided sufficient information for OCR to infer that the listed Recipients are discriminating against female students on the basis of sex in intercollegiate athletics.

OCR's letter asked that you provide information about your *specific concerns and the particular circumstances* that demonstrate that female students are not provided equal athletic opportunities because of a failure to fully and effectively accommodate the interests and abilities of female students with respect to the opportunities provided to participate in intercollegiate athletics. We



requested that you provide specific, **current**, reliable information to support that the interests and abilities of female students are not being met and gave you an example of this type of data or information (i.e., data or information indicating a significant number of female students from the college or university are participating in competitive club or intramural sports that are not offered as intercollegiate sports by the Recipient). OCR informed you that it would dismiss your complaint if you did not provide the additional information by March 11, 2014.

In addition to the February 18, 2014 email, you also subsequently provided several news articles in support of your complaints. These news articles referred to 9 of the 121 complaints you filed.² The news articles you provided were dated from August 9, 2004 to May 17, 2012. None of those articles are considered timely under OCR case processing standards. Therefore, your responses do not provide any further specific, **current**, reliable information to support your allegation of noncompliance by the listed Recipients. Accordingly, OCR is dismissing complaints 09-14-2070 through 09-14-2190 effective the date of this letter.
