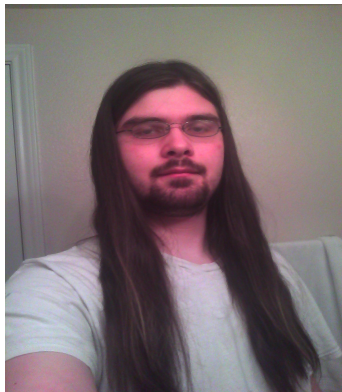
After spending 7 months ill, Ken has been writing a lot, submitting his work to several publications. His goal is to begin publishing his work. He's very talented.



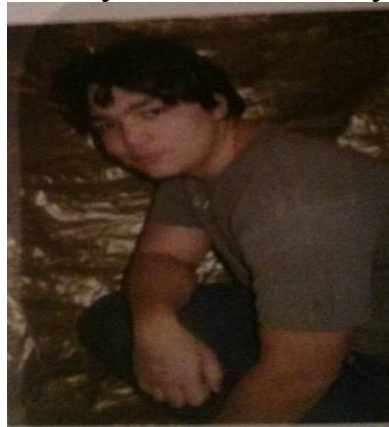
Ali was fortunate to get a job teaching accounting at ACC. She loves the work, and her students. And of course, she still does consulting and tax preparation.



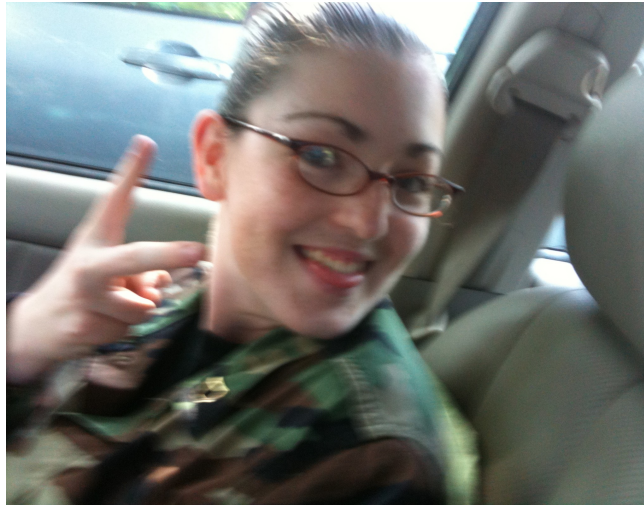
