# VCCCV Pattern

Two-syllable words with the VCCCV pattern have two consonants that spell one sound, as in *laugh*ter, or that form a cluster, as in *com*plain*. Divide a VCCCV word into syllables before or after those consonants. Then look for familiar patterns that you have learned, and spell the word by syllables.*
