Lions Club International Youth Exchange



Lions Henry & Lorrie attended the fall District 29-I conference at Blackwater Falls State Park. One of the people we met was Lion Sue Via. She did a short presentation on the Lions Youth Exchange program. I expressed an interest in the program and learned that there is a young girl from Peru wishing to come to West Virginia. After much thought and discussion, we decided to pursue the idea of hosting her. We notified Lion Sue that we wanted to host this student. She sent us the student's application to review.

We then asked our Lions Club to be the host club, which you graciously accepted.

We will be hosting Meylin Tan a 15-year-old high school student who lives in Lima, Peru. She has travelled to the US one time visiting Los Angeles, CA. She made application to come to the US through the Lions Youth Exchange program specifically requesting to come to West Virginia.

Meylin will be arriving at Dulles airport on January 17, 2013 and will stay with us through February 26, 2013. She will accompany Lorrie and me to our Lions Club meetings. Meylin doesn't know it yet, but she will make a presentation at our February 13, 2013 meeting.



Capon Valley Neighbor to Neighbor Health Fair



On Saturday October 27, 2012, Wardensville Lions Club participated in the first Capon Valley Neighbor to Neighbor community health fair held at the Capon Valley Ruritan building. The American Red Cross was there and they received over 20 pints of blood. Valley Health did cholesterol and blood sugar screenings. Hampshire County Health Department provided flu shots and Hampshire County Sheriff's Department was there with their drug sniffing dog and providing and recording child identification for parents. Beltone

was there doing hearing tests and Capon Springs fire department had smoke and CO₂ detectors they gave away. Over 65 people attended the health fair and we did about half a dozen eye screenings. Over all, everyone was happy with the turn out for a first time event. Next year's health fair is scheduled for October 26, 2013 at Capon Valley Ruritan.
