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Skill Level = Intermediate

You can tat just one side of this for a great edging. You can make bookmarks from it, or if you are ambitious you can make a chatelaine. (That's what I designed it for.)

Optional: Instead of using RW you can tat this directionally for front/backside tatting

R=ring

SCMR= Self Closing Mock Ring

Ch=chain P,-=picot

LP=Long Picot

J,+=join

RW=Reverse Work

CTM=Continuous Thread Method

S=start

±=p on first iteration then j throughout rest of pattern

2 shuttles wound CTM

- *r12±6-6cl rw, ch 5 rw, r5(+ last p of prev r)10-5 cl
- r5+7(LP)2(+LP to make Double Picot)7-5cl
- r5+10-5 cl rw, ch 5 rw, r6+6-12 cl rw
- ch2±10, throw off r5-5, ch10
- r5-5, SCMR 5+5, throw off r6, 5-5 cl rw
- ch10, throw off r5-5, ch10-2
- Repeat from * until desired length
- Note: Once you've gone around the corner you attach to your existing "thrown off" r5-5 instead of tatting a new one.
