Youth Ministry Position
“Associate Director of Youth Ministry Events & Programs”

The Associate Director of Youth Ministry Events & Programs at Custer Road United Methodist Church shall be a person of genuine and deepening Christian character, willing to grow as a loyal participant of a ministry team, able to work and communicate well, build a volunteer base, and cultivate trust with other people in a growing congregation.

Purpose: The purpose of the Associate Director of Youth Ministry Events & Programs is to support youth in their journey with Christ through events and special programs.

Hours: The Associate Director of Youth Ministry Events & Programs will be a full-time employee and will be governed by Custer Road’s full-time employee policies.

Staff Supervision: Reports to the Director of Youth Ministries.

Job Functions: In conformity with Custer Road’s policies, the Associate Director of Youth Ministry Events & Programs will:

- Recruit, train, and support laity for special events and programs.
- Manage all communication for special events and programs.
- Manage registration and administrative functions for special events and programs.
- Design curriculum for special events and programs.
- Take a leadership role with special events and programs(when appropriate).
- Existing events include:
 - Survivor (Fall Weekend retreat)
 - HIGH SCHOOL Breakaway (Spring break trip)
 - MIDDLE SCHOOL Breakaway (Spring Break Trip)
 - 6th Mission Adventure (Summer, 2 day event)
 - 7/8th Mission Trip (week long, summer)
 - HIGH SCHOOL Mission Trip (Week-long, summer to Crossville, TN)
 - HIGH SCHOOL Mission Trip (Week-long, summer, Urban immersion experience)
 - Youth Week (7 days of fun and worship)
 - Confirmation (8 week course, twice each year)
 - 8th Sex Ed Retreat (Spring, 2 days)
 - HIGH SCHOOL Human Sexuality Retreat (Spring, 2 days)
 - HIGH SCHOOL Guys Event
 - HIGH SCHOOL Girls Event
 - Quarterly Grade-level Events
 - Pilgrimage Special Events and Retreats (3+ annually)

- In partnership with youth ministry staff members, develop additional new events and program for youth.
- Implement new ministry programs and events using volunteers as envisioned by youth staff members.
- Support weekly programs with attendance.
- Participate in weekly worship with youth.
- Interact weekly with youth to care and support them in their spiritual journeys.
- Interact and care for adults who volunteer as investors on a weekly basis.
- Care for and nurture high school girls in their life struggles and spiritual journey.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Must maintain confidentiality.
- Must be creative and administratively skilled.
- Ability to handle conflict with grace.
- Must have a positive attitude and a spirit of grace and patience while working with staff and laity.
- Must have positive team building skills.
