PLAINTIFFS' SPECIAL JURY INSTRUCTION

**Proof of Actual Malice**

Actual malice may be proved by circumstantial evidence. Although personal ill will by itself is not sufficient to prove actual malice, a combination of Kramer's anger, hostility toward the Plaintiffs, failure to investigate or subsequent conduct may all constitute circumstantial evidence that actual malice existed.

Evidence alone of Kramer's animosity, hatred, spite or ill will toward Kelman or Globaltox does not establish actual malice.
