## Skill Level = Intermediate

2 shuttles, 2 colors 1 dark color, 1 light color

- Join threads and tat over tails in the first R and ch.
- R7rw SS, ch20 SS,
- \*SR 12/3-3-3, ch16rw, SS
- SR 7/9, ch10 [throw off r 3+(1 st p)3cl]10+(lj base of SR)
- SR 7/9, ch8 [throw off r 3+(next p)3cl]8+(lj base of SR)
- SR 7/9, ch6 [throw off r 3+(next p)3cl] 6+(lj base of SR)
- SR 7/9rw, SS ch12+(lj base of large SR)rw, SS
- Repeat from\* for second wing
- ch20, r7

Finish ends
