Membership

The Committee membership consists of NGOs in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) of the United Nations and members of the Conference of NGOs (CONGO) at the United Nations in Geneva who are including the spiritual and values dimension in their work and policy.

Voting members are those individuals who represent organizations in Consultative Status with the UN through ECOSOC; there is one vote per organization. Individuals may be members without vote.

Participation

is open to other international governmental or non-governmental organizations as well as civil society individually or collectively wishing to participate and aspiring to the same goals. Links and collaboration with other NGOs and UN organizations in New York and Vienna are also being established.

Membership Benefits:

Members will receive notices of regular meetings, special publications and updates on activities of the CSVGC, plus invitations to all special events, receptions and meetings sponsored by *CSVGC*. In addition, the Committee brings NGO representatives together to issue joint statements, facilitates NGO participation at CSVGC meetings, conducts training and orientation for NGO representatives, and runs a regularly updated website that keeps members worldwide informed.
