# New Year Doily

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A doily with cluny tatting, split rings and split chains



# **Materials:**

Tatting cotton size 40 in white and ecru. Two tatting shuttles.

#### Method:

Fill one shuttle with white (W) and one with ecru (E) and tie together.

#### Round 1:

All rings white and all chains ecru.

R1 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, cl, RW

\*Ch1 4 - 4 - 4 - 4, RW

R2 5 + 5 - 5 - 5, cl, RW

Rep from \* until 7 rings (joining the last picot to the first picot of R1) and 6 chains have been made.

Ch7 SC 4-4/4-4 DNRW



#### Round 2:

All chains white.

Ch1 mp 7 - 7 - 7 - 7, j with lj to next centre p of round 1 Ch2 7 - 7 - 7 - 7, j with lj to next centre p of round 1

Continue round until 6 chains have been made.

Ch7 SC 7-7-7/7 DNRW

# Round 3:

All Clunies are made with 16 passes using W shuttle for loom and E shuttle for weaving. Make 2 clunies one after the other and j with lj to first p of next chain on round 2.

Ch1 (W) 4 - 4, lj to next p Ch2 (W) 4 - 4, lj to next p

Rep all round making the last chain a SC of 4 / 4, DNRW

# Round 4:

Ch1 (W) 7 - 7 - 7 - 7 , lj to p of Ch1 on round 3 Ch2 (E) 5 - 5 , lj to p of Ch2 on round 3. Rep all round making last chain a SC of 5 / 5, DNRW

# Round 5:

All the SRs in this round are made with the ecru shuttle as the first half and the white shuttle as the second half.

SR1 5 - 5 / 5 - 5, cl SR2 5 - 5 / 5 - 5, cl

SR3 5-5/5+ (joining to centre p of Ch1 on prev round) 5, cl

SR4 5 - 5 / 5 - 5, cl

SR5 5 - 5 / 5 - 5, cl, lj to p of Ch2 on round 4)

Rep all round joining last ring to first ring, cut, tie and neaten ends,

# Round 6:

All chains in this round are white. Attach thread to p of centre SR of any scallop on round 5  $\,$ 

\*Ch1 7 - 7 - 7 - 7 - 7, miss 1 SR on round 5 and lj between next 2 SRs.

Ch2 7 + (j to last p of prev Ch) 7 - 7 - 7, lj to centre of next scallop on round 5.

Rep from  $\mbox{*}$  all round making the last chain as follows

Ch14 7 + (j to last p of prev Ch) 7 - 7 - 7 / 7, DNRW

# Round 10:

All chains in this round are white. Attach thread to p of centre SR of any scallop on round 9

\*Ch1 7 - 7 - 7 - 7 - 7, lj to p of centre SR of next scallop.

Rep from \* all round making the last chain a SC as follows:

Ch14 7 - 7 - 7 - 7 - 7 / 7, DNRW

#### Round 11:

All Clunies are made with 16 passes using W shuttle for loom and E shuttle for weaving.

\*Make 2 clunies one after the other and j with lj to first p of next chain on round 10.

Ch1 7 - 7, miss next p on same ch of round 10 and j to next p

Ch2 7 - 7,miss next p on same ch of round 10 and j to next p

Rep from \* all round making the last chain a SC of 7 / 7, DNRW

# Round 12:

Ch1 (W) 9 - 9 - 9 - 9 , lj to p of Ch1 on round 11 Ch2 (E) 7 - 7 , lj to p of Ch2 on round 11. Rep all round making last chain a SC of 7 / 7, DNRW

# Round13:

All the SRs in this round are made with the ecru shuttle as the first half and the white shuttle as the second half.

SR1 6 - 6 / 6 - 6, cl SR2 6 - 6 / 6 - 6, cl

SR3 6-6/6+ (joining to centre p of Ch1 on prev round) 6, cl

SR4 6 - 6 / 6 - 6, cl

SR5 6 - 6 / 6 - 6, cl, lj to p of Ch2 on prev round)

Rep all round joining last ring to first ring, DNRW

# Round 14:

\*Ch1 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2, lj to tiny space between next two SR on prev row.

Rep from \* all round joining to starting point.

Cut, tie and neaten ends.



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
