To meet standard:

Title slide with name of country and group members

Map slide that shows location of country on the continent

Slide with basic background information: type of government, type of economy, population, ethnic/religious groups, per capita income, literacy rate, life expectancy

Slide on the top challenge the country faces; remarks demonstrate understanding of the challenge; demonstrates evaluation and synthesis of research material; appropriate visual

Slide on the top opportunity for the country; remarks demonstrate understanding of the potential; demonstrates evaluation and synthesis of research material; appropriate visual

Slide on the top success for the country; remarks demonstrate understanding of the success; demonstrates evaluation and synthesis of research material; appropriate visual

Slides have limited written information and rely on visuals to help tell the story

Source slide includes at least 3 varied sources including at least one newspaper or journal from the country studied

All students speak, use of note cards (handed in); shows that presentation has been practiced; able to respond to questions

To Exceed the standard

Unique visuals that help with the understanding of the content

Evaluation of challenges, opportunities and successes shows in depth research and understanding of the topic; good insights and observations

Use of wide range of sources (at least 6) including at least 2 sources from the country

Responses to questions demonstrate in depth knowledge of the topics
