Spring Book Fair and Visit by Author Highlight the Importance of Reading


It's no secret that reading enhances kids' education, and to encourage that, the DEC will host a presentation by children's book author Maureen Wright on Tuesday, May 13.

A resident of Athens, in Bradford County, Mrs. Wright has published several children's picture books. Success came after 20 years of rejections by publishers. She visits schools to tell her story to children and urge them to follow their dreams and not give up.

In an assembly for kindergarten through second grades, Mrs. Wright will read two books, answer questions and do an interactive program teaching writing tips. In two assemblies for third through sixth grades, she will read one book, answer questions and do a program introducing students to the process of getting a story accepted by an editor and published. Students will get to unroll long lines of her taped-together rejection letters to see a visual representation of her theme of perseverance.

Mrs. Wright's books are available for purchase through her Web site, www.booksbymaureenwright.com. Students who bring her books to the assemblies can have them autographed.

The author presentation follows on the heels of the PTA's Spring Book Fair, which takes place Monday, May 5 through Thursday, May 8. Family night is on Wednesday, May 7 from 6 to 8 p.m. and the makeup day is Friday, May 9. The event offers a Buy One Book, Get One Free option for students.
