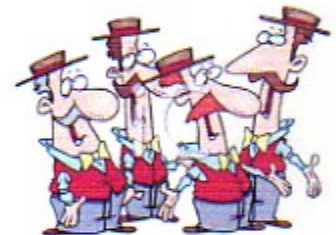
Family Picnic Scheduled for June 26, 2013
