9 10	AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT			
11	I, Detective Angelo Orefice, as your affiant herein and being duly sworn and upon my oath,			
12	do depose and state the following:			
13	Your Affiant is a Peace Officer of the State of Oklahoma as defined in Title 21 Section 99			
14	of the Oklahoma Statutes and currently employed by the Bethany Police Department as a detective.			
15	In that role I investigate all manner of crimes up to and including homicide. I have been an officer			
16	for the City of Bethany for approximately seven years. Prior to that I was a Special Agent for the			
17	United States Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) for approximately ten years.			
18	I have received specialized training in virtually every type of narcotic investigation there is.			
19	I graduated from DEA's basic agent training academy which is seventeen weeks long, and since			
20	that time have received hundreds of hours of in-service training in drug and various other types of			
21	investigations. I have been involved in the undercover purchase and sale of illicit drugs, and acting			
22	as either case agent, undercover, or in assisting role have been involved in literally hundreds of			
23	different drug investigations. These have spanned street-level drug dealers on up to Mexican cartel			
24	drug trafficking organizations.			
25	I am currently one of several detectives investigating the brutal murder of Carina Saunders			
26	whose dismembered body was found stuffed in a duffle bag behind a Homeland food store in			
27	Bethany, Oklahoma, on October 13, 2011. During the course of this investigation myself and other			

detectives had interviewed in excess of eighty witnesses and have followed up on hundreds of 1 investigative leads in the case. For the past several months, we have heard from various sources 2 that a digital video recording exists of the murder of Saunders but to date no one in law 3 enforcement has been able to confirm the existence of this video. 4 One of the persons purported to have a copy of this video is a female known to me as 5 On October 13, 2011 the body of Carina Saunders was found dismembered and stuffed in 6 a duffle bag in Bethany, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, an obvious victim of homicide. Your 7 applicant has received information from various sources that a digital video recording of the crime 8 or some portion thereof exists and that a female identified as has a copy of this video. 9 Detective Austin Warfield spoke with on July 2, 2012 at her cell phone number 10 and she agreed to come to the police department for an interview. However, she never 11 showed. Shortly thereafter, I received a call from the office of a local attorney whom I know and 12 he stated that he had been contacted on behalf of a woman who supposedly had a video of a murder 13 but was scared to come forward. 14 On July 3, 2012 Detective Warfield obtained an order to ascertain the physical location of the 15 cell phone referenced above and used by . We had received information that she was in the 16 vicinity of the Studio Six Motel at 3850 S. Prospect. I proceeded to that location and observed a 17 female appearing to be walking outside in front of the building. Myself and Detective 18 , and learned from her that Warfield made contact with her, determined it was in fact 19 she was staying in a nearby room at the motel. She took us to room number 118 whereupon we 20 knocked on the door and allowed those inside to see that Cottier was outside. When the door was 21 opened from the inside, I produced a badge, announced I was a police officer, and that I wanted to 22 speak with those inside. Through the open doorway I observed in plain view a handgun laying on 23

the bed. For officer safety reasons, I made entry and secured the room by having all occupants step 1 outside, leaving the weapon laying in plain view on the bed. 2 Room 118 is rented to CHRISTOPHER BANSCHBACH, white male, born August 8, 1985; 3 both he and a female were inside the room. The female asked why she was being detained and I 4 replied because there is a gun, and probably methamphetamine, inside the room. Neither of them 5 denied my statement about meth likely being in the room, but BANSCHBACH denied any 6 knowledge of a gun. It should be noted that while he was making this denial, the gun was within 7 his arm's reach, in plain view, on top of the bed. A records check reveals that BANSCHBACH has 8 felony convictions in Oklahoma County case numbers CF-2009-6624, CF-2010-960, and Cf-2010-9 5174 and by being in the room with the above referenced handgun is in violation of Oklahoma 10 Statutes Title 21 Section 1283. All of these felony convictions include drug possession charges, 11 specifically methamphetamine, and one count in CF-2010-5174 is for possession of 12 methamphetamine with intent to distribute. 13 While inside the room securing the firearm I observed on top of a nightstand a trace amount of a 14 tannish powder, which based upon my training and experience appears to be methamphetamine. In 15 BANSCHBACH'S left front pants pocket was a cell phone and a large sum of currency; it appeared 16 to be three separate stacks of twenty dollar bills folded together, and appeared to total several 17 hundred dollars. During the time I was there BANSCHBACH's cell phone rang repeatedly. 18 Additionally, the motel manager told me that last night, July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2012, there was a lot of foot traffic 19 in and out of this room, so much so that she had to shut them down and stop them from having 20 additional visitors. 21 Because the currency was separated into stacks of a certain amount, and appeared to be all 22 twenty dollar bills which is a common amount for street-level drug sales, and the high volume of 23

- 1 cell phone calls, foot traffic in and out of the room, BANSCHBACH'S multiple drug/meth prior
- 2 convictions, and what I believe may be meth residue on the table top, it is my opinion that this
- 3 room is being utilized by BANSCHBACH to conduct illegal drug activity.
- 4 I respectfully request that a search warrant issue directing a search of the premises located in
- 5 Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma:
- 6 ROOM 118 OF THE STUDIO SIX MOTEL, 3850 S. PROSPECT, OKLAHOMA CITY,
- 7 OKLAHOMA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA,
- 8 And authorizing the seizure of the following:
- Any and all firearms, and all controlled dangerous substances, including but not limited to 9 methamphetamine; paraphernalia related to the distribution and/or consumption 10 methamphetamine, including but not limited to scales, syringes, and other devices commonly 11 used for smoking or ingesting these and other drugs; Drug records related to the sale of 12 illegal narcotics, including, but not limited to, address books, notebooks, personal computers, 13 correspondence, electronic data storage devices, video tapes, photographs, audio tapes, 14 papers, receipts, and other documents evidencing the obtaining, secretion, transferring 15 and/or concealment of controlled dangerous substances and/or money obtained and/or used 16 in the trafficking, importation, purchase and/or distribution of controlled dangerous 17 substances; United States Currency furnished or intended to be furnished in exchange for a 18 controlled dangerous substance in violation of 63 O.S. 2-503 et seq., and articles of personal 19 property tending to establish the identity of the person or persons in control or possession of 20 the premises including but not limited to mail envelopes, vehicle registration, credit card 21 receipts, keys, and articles of clothing 22
