Dear Mr. Miller and Mr. Wiener,

My name is Sharon Kramer. For five years I have been a defendant in a libel litigation in San Diego. The sole claim of the case is that my phrase "altered his under oath statements" was a maliciously false accusation of perjury.

For five years, I have been providing the San Diego courts with uncontroverted and irrefutable evidence that the plaintiff was committing perjury to established a needed reason for my malice for him personally as I spoke of a deceit by the US Chamber of Commerce and others, including the plaintiff, that is adverse to the health and safety of the American public.

I year ago, I filed a complaint with the Ca State Bar against the plaintiff's attorney, Keith Scheuer, for willfully suborning his client's perjury, thereby allowing the deceit in health policy to continue to flourish by discrediting me and thus my whistleblowing words.

This was Complaint No. 09-2006, February 2009. I provided to the State Bar uncontroverted and irrefutable evidence of Mr. Scheuer's willful suborning of his client's perjury in the form of court records, deposition testimonies, declarations, affidavits of other attorneys and even videos of Mr. Scheuer's client discussing that his declarations submitted to the courts under oath were contradicting with his deposition statements made under oath on the issue of malice.

The State Bar basically replied with "We don't get it". With all due respect, I find it difficult to believe that an entire organization made up of those who hold legal licenses were unable to comprehend that when under oath declaration statements conflict with under oath deposition statements, there is a problem with one of their licensees.

As a result of the California State Bar's failure to reign in a rogue attorney, a deception involving the US Chamber of Commerce et al, – an interstate fraud on the courts continues to flourish adversely to the health and safety of the American public; and involving other California licensed attorneys.

I am writing to you today to let you know your role in the matter. A new complaint will be forthcoming regarding Mr. Scheuer's continued willful suborning of his client's perjury by using the "just say no" defense as the case, amazingly, continues in the San Diego courts, with Mr. Scheuer continuing to submit briefs suborning the perjury in the face of uncontroverted evidence. His client is a co-author of medico-legal policy papers on behalf of the US Chamber of Commerce and the American College of Occupational and Environmental Medicine. My purportedly libelous writing of 2005 was the first to publicly name the names of the entities involved and how these two papers were connected.

Attached is a notarized letter to one of the listed co-authors of the US Chamber of Commerce's "A Scientific View of the Health Effects of Mold" (2003). He is a University of California physician who states under oath that he had no knowledge of being named as co-author of the US Chamber medico legal policy paper – that has now been submitted into the court records of a legal proceeding in Arizona involving another California licensed attorney, Mr. Russell Hiles and his associate, Frank Kuratz.

This letter to the UC physician is not only being sent to you, it is being sent to many decision makers in a effort to stop a fraud on the courts that is adverse to the health and safety of the US public.

I would appreciate it, if the California State Bar would go back and review the evidence provided to them in Complaint No. 09-2006. It is irrefutable evidence that the author of "A Scientific View of the Health Effects of Mold" and his attorney, Mr. Keith Scheuer, have been strategically litigating by criminal means to silence me; thereby aiding Mr. Hiles, his associate, Frank Kuratz, and the attorneys of the Arizona case to mislead the Arizona courts.

Thank you for your help with this very serious matter.
