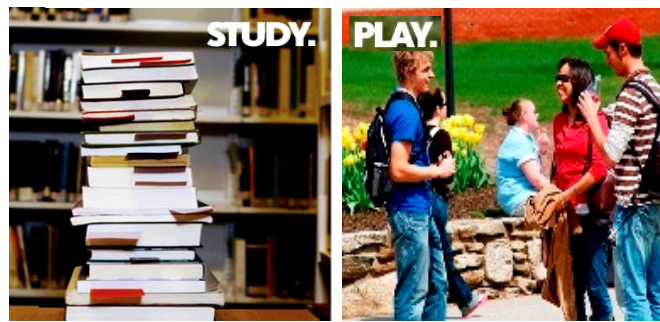

Initial Consultation Meeting - "Lone Star Basic"

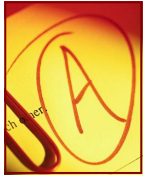
Lauren Kahn will meet with you approximately two hours to review your student's educational outlook based upon their transcript (rigor of curriculum, GPA, and projected ranking), a writing sample, extra curricular activities, and informal interviews with both the student and parent(s).

Comprehensive College Planning - "Lone Star Plus"

- ✧ An Ed Consultant will provide you assistance with all phases of the college search and application process. The consultant will help you select colleges best suited to your student's academic and social needs. This package is the most economical, and works best for families that want to be engaged from the beginning to the end of the college planning process. The initial consultation meeting is included.
- ✧ Interviews with student and parent(s) to assess academic and behavioral goals, as well as social, geographic, and financial considerations (FAFSA and scholarship information).
- ✧ College advisement includes; extra curricular activity and H.S. class choice recommendations, SAT /ACT test prep suggestions, internship/summer program recommendations, college selection, career / major / interest assessments, brainstorming on essay topics, resume creation, campus interview preparation, campus visit tips, and reviewing of online college applications.
- ✧ Essay review for up to eight college applications. Each essay will be written by the student, and edited in collaboration with the student's input.
- ✧ Regular memos will be sent requesting and following up on student's application deadlines and other time commitments.
- ✧ Newsletters with articles on tips during the college admission process and trends in the industry will be sent on a bi-annual basis.

For students who begin the college planning process during their sophomore or junior year, there will be approximately eight face-to-face meetings. For students who begin the process senior year, there will be approximately six meetings. Some meetings will include both parent(s) and student, while others will only include the student.
