

## **More techniques:**

Use a doily as a stencil

Use a doily on the page

Doodle

Use a punch to edge the opening side of the page

Put a border round the page

Use a stamp you don't often use

Add white paint or gesso to make highlights on the page

Add black paint to make highlights

Use vegetables to stamp with eg potato, celery, leek

Cut out triangles and attach them to the page to look like bunting

Add flowers to the page

Use Rub-Ons

Use Vellum

Use Ribbon

Use Twine

Use yellow - paint or paper

Use an image cut from a magazine.

Use your computer to print an image to print on sticky backed canvas and cut out and stick onto the page

Use embossing powder

Use chipboard. Either cut a shape or use a pre-cut shape

Put masking tape onto your page to create texture

Put masking tape lightly on your page to create a pattern. Add ink or paint to the page. Carefully remove masking tape

Use crackle medium on your page

Crumple tissue paper and then slightly smooth it out and glue to all or part of your page with gel medium or pva glue. Leave to dry

Use glitter or perfect pearls to add shine to your page.

Add metal to the page. This could be a bought embellishment. Or cut out a shape from an empty soft drinks can either with scissors or a diecutting machine
