We have now been able to piece together the information you had requested. As this was not held in a structured format we have had to ask the various departments throughout the Council if they had any premises that had closed. I am sure you can appreciate that changes in personnel have occurred and there has also been changes in the structure of the Council which has made this task difficult and complex to complete. I apologise once again for the delay and the fact that we did not provide this earlier.

Only one property has been identified that fits all the criteria of your request:

89 Bishops Way London E2 9HL, a 6 bed residential home vacated due to reduced service requirements, this has not been sold and is currently occupied by guardian company for security reasons.

There are however several youth centres or venues from which youth services used to operate from – many of which were delivered by third parties under an SLA arrangement (which were terminated following a review in March 2016). The only Council owned premises which were vacated are as follows:

Martineau Youth Centre porta cabin, Martineau Square London E1 1XP

10 Turin Street, London E2 6NJ

Bangladeshi Youth Movement, Berner Centre, Polner Street, E1 1QN

The following locations were used for Youth Services delivery but the Council did not own or control the buildings in any way:

Shadow Youth Alliance Minerva Hall, Unit 3 & 4, Connett House, 1 Teesdale St, London E2 6GF

St Hilda's East Community Centre, 18 Club Row, London E2 7EY

East London Tabernacle, Burdett Road, London , E3 4TU
