

*Pattern for ONE Necklace  
UP beads*

*For the half necklace you will need:  
4-5 yards of thread size 10 and about 500 seed beads size 11.*



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- 1) R: 2 •••• •••• 2.RW  
2) CH: 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1.LJ  
3) R: 2 •••• •••• 2.RW  
4) CH: 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1.LJ  
5) R: 2 •••• •••• 2.RW  
6) CH: 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1.LJ  
7) R: 2 •••• •••• 2.RW  
8) CH: 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1.LJ  
9) R: 2 •••• •••• 2.RW  
10) CH: 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1.LJ  
11) R: 2 •••• ••~• 2.RW  
12) CH: 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1 • 1.LJ

Keep going until you have the length you need for the necklace.

***SYMBOLS USED THROUGH THE PATTERN:***

- 1, 2, 3** number of double knots;
- R** ring;
- SR** split ring;
- CH** chain;
- picot;
- + regular join;
- LJ** lock join (joining with shuttle thread);
- . shape, tighten, and close a ring;
- RW** reverse work;

- **1** seed beads '**up**'(on knotting thread)
- **3** seed beads '**up**'(on knotting thread for a *POINTED* picot)
- **5** seed beads '**up**'(on knotting thread for a *POINTED* picot)
- ••••• **12** seed beads '**up**'(on knotting thread)
- •••• **8** seed beads '**up**'(on knotting thread)

*'UP' beads come from the knotting thread (the ball or the left hand shuttle, or the loop on your left hand);*

*'DOWN' beads are ALWAYS - ALWAYS from the core thread (shuttle or tail in your right hand.*
