3.	Intermediate Any Age	85cm/2'9"
4.	Open Any age	100cm/3'3"

1. Classes to be run under Pony Club Team Show Jumping rules with 2 rounds and no 3rd round jump-off and in accordance with Area 5 Winter League Rules (amended 2014) to accommodate WL and non-WL teams and individuals with appropriate course changes. Points will be awarded in accordance with the Winter League Rules.
2. In the first round the whole team will jump in succession. In the second round the team members will jump one at a time, one from each team, in the order they jumped in the first round sequentially - rule 7.7 & 7.9.2.
3. Branches entering more than one team in any one class must clearly identify their Winter League Team and teams to be named to distinguish.
4. Ages as at January 1st 2017.
