Kings Crescent Community Hall N4 2XG	Community Hall	Demolished in 2014 (temporary facility opened in the same year)
Sam and Annie Day Centre E6 8RL	Day Centre	Building has been re-Let commercially.

No libraries or school buildings have been closed since 2010.
