Each of the groups have their own style and sing a wide variety of music all performed in the barbershop style.

Just 4 Fun, a mixed barbershop quartet, began their musical journey in January of 2004. The quartet sings traditional barbershop style music including gospel, doo wop, jazz and pop. Their unique sound has been heard throughout Maryland, Pennsylvania, West Virginia, Virginia, Ohio and New Jersey.

Lisa Tompkins lends her soft, lilting voice to the tenor part, while **Kevin McKenzie** delivers a poignant lead melody. The quartet gets its foundation from the deep resonating bass of **Roger Anderson** and the rich baritone voice of **Wendy Anderson** completes the quartet's smooth a cappella sound. Lisa and Kevin live in LaVale, MD and Roger and Wendy reside in Augusta, WV.

The group performs throughout the year for church functions, barbershop shows, parties and various other functions. **Just 4 Fun** is a member of the Mixed Harmony Barbershop Quartet Association (MHBQA). Since their current alignment was established in June 2007, the quartet has performed at churches, on shows, in divisional and International preliminary competitions, and as part of the Atlantic Harmony Brigade, traveling to Maryland, West Virginia, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Delaware, and New Jersey.
