HE5489 OnRail Phosphorous Tank Wagon (Train Ferry Authorised)

Release Date: Summer 2012

Availability: Limited production of 500 pieces. Electrotren branding.

Specification: 165 mm length. Fine livery application, phosphor staining and weathering.

History: One of 10 80 Ton Tank wagons used under contract from German firm OnRail. Used mainly to bring Phosphor into the UK to make fire retardant and water treatment compounds.

GV6000 Tarpaulin wagon Norsk Hydro Fertilisers - weathered

Release Date: Summer 2013

Availability: Limited production of 500 pieces. Rivarossi branding.

Specification: 227 mm length. Fine livery application with Norsk Hydro Branding. Produced with permission of Yara and Hydro.

History: Builder: Inge Trans 1986 (E.598). Fixed end walls and plastic coated fabric sheet allowed the loading of 'big bags' of fertilizers.

Hydro produced the product at their Immingham factory and transferred it by rail to Scotland, South Wales and the South of England.

Livery: Norsk Hydro Fertilizers

GV6001 Tarpaulin wagon Tiphook Steel Express - weathered

Release Date: Autumn 2013

Availability: Limited production of 500 pieces. Rivarossi branding.

Specification: 227 mm length. Tiphook Rail 'Steel Express' branding with light weathering.

History: Builder: Arbel Fauvet 1987. Converted in 1990 to hooded flat wagons and coded under TOPS as KIA. Carrying imported and home produced coil steel to stock holders. Coverage: Across UK and Europe.

GV6003 Brown Ferry Wagon DB, Gs wagon with Railway Transportation Corps/WD logos

Release Date: Summer 2013

Availability: Limited production of 500 pieces. Rivarossi branding.

Specification: 121 mm length. War Department (ex DB) Branding. With chalk destinations – one side UK Military bases, the other side European British Army Bases.

History: Type Gs. Used after the second world war by the British Army to move stores and equipment throughout the UK and Europe.

GV6008 Depressed centre tank wagon Tiphook Rail branding

Release Date: Feb 2013

Availability: Limited production of 500 pieces. Rivarossi branding.

Specification: Hornby UK Couplings.

History: Used from 1970's through to recent past for moving oils through the UK and into Europe. Channel Tunnel approved



HR6121 Steel and Iron works – Torpedo wagon

Release Date: January 2012

Availability: Rivarossi Catalogue range.

Specification: Euro couplings. 220 mm length. Weathered

History: Used within Steel works to move the liquid Iron and Steel around the complex.

Release Date: Current

Availability: Lima Catalogue range.

Specification: Euro couplings. 102 mm length. With floating cleaning pad under tanker.

Release Date: 2012

Specification: Euro couplings. 175 mm length.

History: Many tons of gran and pelleted products were moved by British Rail as part of the Speedlink network. After the demise of the network, several short term flows continued to use Polybulks from Transcereals.

GV8001 British Army rail adapted Mk2 Land Rover

Release Date: December 2012

Availability: 2,500 piece production run. Oxford Diecast branding.

Specification: 1:76 scale.

History: The Army was always keen on finding flexible and simple methods of moving their railway wagons. In the early 1960's this included converting a Mk2 Land Rover and adding rail wheels. This particular model led to the development of many more rail based Land Rovers.
