DECLARATION OF RICHARD A. SHAPIRO

The foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge
and belief:

1. ON March 9, 2012, I was present for a hearing before Judge
Thomas P. Nugent concerning my own case, and was aware that
said judge incarcerated for five days, via same hearing, an
unrelated litigant, Sharon Kramer, for refusing to commit
perjury upon said judge's orders.

1 2. Just before said judge incarcerated Mrs. Kramer on March 9,
2 2012, for not committing perjury per his orders, the Judge
3 referred to an unrelated litigant to the Kelman v. Kramer case,
4 that he (Mr. Shapiro) was "disturbed" and "because of such he
5 should not be associated with."

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7 3. At a Department 30, April 12, 2009 hearing, I witnessed in
8 open court said judge repeatedly state "I understand" to
9 litigant Kramer's straightforward declaration in open court
10 that "instant judge had no jurisdiction over her case, the
11 Kelman v. Kramer case."

12
13 4. In an April 27, 2012 hearing before him, I witnessed more
14 irrational behavior from said judge by way of him implicitly
15 and explicitly notifying, and having present, two or more law
16 enforcement agents in the courtroom especially there for me,
17 via my cogent and case pertinent criticisms to him via
18 submitted court papers and statements made in open court before
19 him.

21 5. It appears to me very likely that said judge is attempting
22 to hinder and tamper with my ability to perform witness duties
23 in the Kelman v. Kramer cases, and have Mrs. Kramer perform the
24 same in my two cases, the Shapiro v. Carlsbad, and the Shapiro
25 v. Shapiro case, via highly contaminating unethical and illegal
26 conduct by him which will easily and materially affect the
27 outcome of these two litigant cases before him.

1 6. I feel absolute outrage to have to be going through this
2 nightmare with a judge that is, for all intents and purposes,
3 presumed to be an impartial, ethical individual who can and
4 will decide the issues on the merits and the law, but despite
5 this widely held reasonable presumption, delivers, behind a
6 thin veil of all things good and right, grossly outrageous
7 conduct toward litigants who personally offend him in some way.
8

9 7. For the foregoing incidents, but not limited to, I feel in
10 grave danger for the safety of myself and of Mrs. Kramer, via
11 our unwillingness to commit perjury, and refusal to cease and
12 desist the practice of our free speech and petition rights
13 guaranteed by the United States Constitution, for which this
14 judge, and all others, are sworn to defend and uphold at all
15 costs.
16

17 I declare, under the penalty of perjury, that the foregoing is
18 true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
