The Essentials of Figure Painting

This figure painting workshop will emphasize the study of the underlying figure structure and how to bring it to life on the canvas. Skeletal study aids of the body and head will be available for aid in observation. Students will also concentrate on the sculptural relationships within the figure and selective interpretation on the canvas. A Thursday evening painting demonstration will set the tone for the weekend and will help to illustrate the important issues that Charles wishes to emphasize. During the demo he will outline his process, method and terminology and will direct students in their goals for the workshop. Students will enjoy one-on-one instruction in a focused group atmosphere during the three full days of painting the figure from life.
