

# **Path for Peace**

## **A Natural Rosary for Peace**

**108 trees were marked around the UN + 5 trees with spiritual quotes**

108 trees were marked with nametags (original name, place and Latin name) in a circle around the UN aiming at creating a Path for peace. The number was not intentional, but emerged as constituting a rosary, in the Buddhist tradition which could be the witness of a higher plan.

Also 5 trees were marked with plaques engraved with spiritual quotes, two of which are extracts from a book on former UN Secretary-General, "*Dag Hammarskjöld – A Spiritual Man*" (by Sven Stolpe, 1966).

All the nametags and quotetags were set up during the UN open day in October 2001. Below are the sentences and their site:

*Meditation Place – Temple of the Winds*

**Silence is Peace**  
***Le Silence est Paix***

*Near opposite the tomb of M. Revillod, donator of the Park*

**Love and Peace start within**  
***Amour et Paix commencent par soi***

*On the beautiful "Cèdre du Liban" in the Center front – the oldest tree of the park*

**We are all seeds of a better world**  
***Nous sommes tous les semences d'un monde meilleur***

*50 meters beside the « Cèdre du Liban » - at the beginning of the path to meditation site*

**« No life is more satisfactory than one  
of selfless service to humanity »**  
***Dag Hammarskjöld (1905-1961)***

*Below the two former trees in the middle, thus forming a triangle*

**« Love and patience, righteousness and humility,  
faith and courage, stillness »**
