Market in Otay Mesa, where the trucks that are inspected at the border and trucks with products purchased in Mexico converge to distribute products for the several different routes in Mexico.


Before leaving, we all gather

The April trip was named to honor **Henry Stuursma.** Henry participated for many years, driving and working with MCCA. He was part of the group that would pick up produce prior to each trip, leaving home early Friday morning in order to get back in time to load trucks. He was one of the earlier workers with MCCA.





The May trip honored Herm Verhoeven. Herm was among the first drivers from the 60's. His father-in-law, Ray Zimmer, one of the founders of MCCA in 1964, and Herm was there at the beginning. Herm drove until 2012, when he decided it was time to retire and leave the driving to someone else.

We are so thankful to have known these men who mentored us as we learned the ways of the road in Mexico.
