ITINERARY – England, Scotland & Wales, Autumn 2020

Saturday, September 26 -

Depart your home city for London Heathrow Airport

Make sure to plan your flight to arrive in London by the afternoon of Sept. 27th.

Sunday, September 27 –

Arrive London Heathrow Airport, transfer to Windsor

Arrive London Heathrow Airport by mid-afternoon and make the short transfer to our Windsor hotel. Relax or stroll the historic streets of Eton and Windsor prior to being hosted to a welcome dinner.

Monday, September 28 – Explore Windsor

The Queens' official residence, Windsor Castle, dominates the colorful town of Windsor. You'll have the day to visit the Castle as our guest, dine at local restaurants and shop the many interesting boutiques. Dinner on your own tonight

Tuesday, September 29 – From Windsor to Bath with visit to Stonehenge

This morning our private motor coach will take us to Salisbury Cathedral (The tallest in England).
