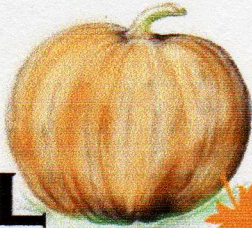
community. Remember, all you have to do is ask. As we grow we can provide additional services to help improve the community in which we live.



### Speakers Program to Restart

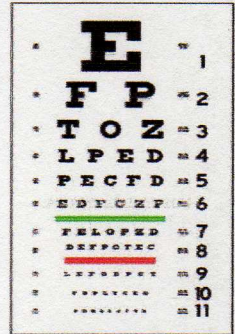

Saturday is when the District cabinet meeting and seminars are held. Registration includes all seminars, Saturday lunch, Saturday evening banquet with entertainment and guest speaker. The Sunday schedule is generally light ending around 1:00 pm.

Registration for the entire conference is \$50 per person. If you plan to spend the night you must make separate arrangements with the hotel – Martinsburg Holiday Inn 304-264-9157. When you contact the hotel for a room reservation, tell the clerk you are with the Lions in order to get the room rate of \$103.04 (tax included) per night. If you want to come but don't want to stay, plan to arrive on Saturday morning about 9:00 am. You can pay \$30 for Saturday and the Saturday banquet. A registration form is attached.
