





## **Assembly Instructions:**

We recommend using PVA (or white) glue and that some parts are best painted **PRIOR** to gluing the building together.


1. Glue along rear edge and tabs of **Back Wall** and insert into corresponding slots on long side of the **Sidewalk**. Glue edges and tabs of **Side Walls** and glue into corresponding tabs, making sure the external decorations face outwards.




2. Glue Lower Curved Guide Rail to Main Guide Rail Support as shown. Aligning rear tabs circled in Red.



3. Glue Inner Guide Rail to top of Main Guide Rail Support as shown. Again, aligning with rear tab circled in Red and with top tab, circled in Black.



4. Glue **Upper Guide Rail** to **Inner Guide Rail** as shown, align as in previous steps, with rear tab circled in **Red** and with top tab, circled in **Black**.



 Glue the Roller Door Top Plate Guide into the top Tab of completed Garage Door Guide Rails as shown.



Repeat Steps 2 to 5 to make an identical copy of the Garage Door Guide Rails.



7. Following steps 2 to 5. Make two
Garage Door Guide Rails that are a
MIRROR image of the previous Garage
Door Guide Rails, as shown.




8. Glue along edge and tabs of Garage Door Guide Rails and insert into corresponding locating slots on rear of Front Wall, as shown.



Side view




9. Glue the **Garage Door Handle** to the tab in the **Garage Doors**, as shown.



10. With the Front Wall facing downwards, insert Garage Doors into Guide Rails. The Garage Door Handles face outwards, along with the darker cut surface of the Garage Door.




11. Glue along edge and tabs of Front Wall and insert into corresponding locating slots on Side Walls and Sidewalk. Align and glue the 9mm square tabs on the upper section of the Guide Rails with the 9mm square holes near the top of the Back Wall.



Hint: low-tack masking tape to secure the edges whilst the glue dries is handy at this point.

12. Glue the Long Roof Balcony and Short Roof Balcony pieces into the corresponding slots as shown.



13. Glue the **Roof Clips** into the slots on the short side of the **Roof** as shown.




14. Glue the Top Wall Decoration, Back Wall Centre Decoration and Back Wall Bottom Decoration to the Back Wall as shown.



15. Glue the **Side Wall Bottom Decorations** to the **Side Walls** as shown, taking note of the orientation of Right and Left Handed Versions of this part.



16. Glue the remaining **Top Wall Decoration** to the top of the **Front Wall as shown.** 




17. Glue the **Side Decorations Male**and Female together as shown to make left and right handed versions.




18. Glue the **Side Decorations** to the corresponding slots in the join between **Front and Back Walls** and **Side Walls**. The 3mm notch in the **Side Decorations** goes uppermost. Ensure the **Side Decorations** sit flush with the walls.



19. Glue the **Wall Centre Decoration** into the slot on the centre beam of the **Front Wall**, with the upper part covering the Top **Wall Decoration** and the bottom part covering the **Gribbly Bit**.



20. Glue the Wall Centre Decoration into the slots in the centre of the Back Wall, with the upper part covering the Top Wall Decoration and the bottom part covering the Back Wall Centre Decoration and Back Wall Bottom Decoration.



21. Glue or the **Vehicle Lift** to the **Sidewalk**inside the M.U.B as
shown. Leave this part
out if using the M.U.B for
another purpose building.



Hint: The Vehicle Lifts are best painted prior to gluing them to The floor.

22. Glue the **Door Supports** into the corresponding notches in the **Door** bottom edge.
