



ITINERARY – Central Europe, April 2024

Tuesday, April 16 – Depart your home city for Prague, Czech Republic

Make sure to schedule your flight to arrive in Prague by the afternoon of April 17th. NOTE: In the past, a few travelers have been confused about departure date and arrival date for the start of our trips. You will need to depart from your home city in the USA on the 16th, in order to arrive for the start of the tour on the 17th.

Wednesday, April 17 -Arrive Prague

Arrive in Prague by mid-afternoon and transfer to our hotel. Relax or stroll the historic streets of Old Town Prague prior to a welcome reception and dinner at an authentic Bohemian restaurant.

Thursday, April 18 -Explore Prague

This morning we will introduce you to the capital of ancient Bohemia with a morning walking tour of Old Town. Its elegant streets present delights around every corner. We will visit its famous Jewish Ghetto and Wenceslas Square where defiant Czechs overthrew the Soviet Empire. Coffee houses and Bohemian beer halls abound. Try one of these for lunch today. Dinner is on your own this evening.

Friday, April 19 -The OTHER side of Prague

Today we will cross the Vltava River to explore Prague Castle and the marvelous St. Vitus Cathedral, then wend our way down the winding streets of the Malá Strana neighborhood before crossing back to Old Town via the famous Charles Bridge.

There's more free time this afternoon for shopping and sightseeing. Scout out a lovely restaurant (On your own) for tonight's supper.

Saturday, April 20 -Free day in Prague

Now that we have the sightseeing out of the way, the day is yours to relax and truly fall in love with this magical city. Sample gourmet food and wine purveyors, explore the side streets, go back to that shop you saw on the first day.

Tonight, you will be our guest for an elegant dinner in a 16th Century restaurant frequented by Czech politicians and international celebrities.

Sunday. April 21 -From Prague to Vienna

This morning our private Motor Coach will transport us on the 3and-a-half-hour drive to Vienna, the capital of Austria. On the outskirts of Vienna, we will make a stop to visit Schönbrunn, the Summer Palace of the Hapsburg Emperors, often referred to as the "Versailles" of Vienna. After checking into Hotel Imperial in the late afternoon, you will sample Viennese cuisine as our guest for dinner at a charming and historic restaurant in the City Center.

Monday, April 22 Morning tour of Vienna's *Innere Stadt* (Old Town)

We will visit many of the city's highlights on this orientation walk – St Stephan's Cathedral, The Burghof - home of the Holy Roman Emperors, the Spanish Riding School, Parliament, and several of Vienna' famed cafés and coffee houses. And we will point out some of the world's great museums which you can visit over the next two days.

The afternoon and evening are yours – there is so much to see and experience in this, the "Paris of Central Europe". Ask us for dining recommendations and suggestions for sightseeing. Whether it be where to get the best Wiener Schnitzel, or the restaurant where both Mozart and Beethoven dined, the restaurant options are wondrous. (Dinner on your own tonight)

Tuesday, April 23 Vienna awaits you!

See Gustav Klimt's famous portrait, "The Kiss", at the Belvedere Palace, attend a rehearsal of Lipizzaner stallions at the Spanish Riding School, have Lunch at **Café Central**, visit Baroque churches and world class museums, have a slice of **Sacher Torte** at hotel Sacher, take a sightseeing bus around "The Ring" for a glimpse of all that Vienna has to offer. And don't forget the upscale shopping in the **Graben** quarter, or the blocks long NASCHMARKT street market for produce, delicacies, clothing and antiques.

Tonight, we will host a dinner and concert at the *Kursalon*. Enjoy Mozart and Strauss waltzes like the Blue Danube, performed in the very room where Johann Strauss conducted, and royalty danced in the 19th -century.

Wednesday, April 24 -From Vienna to Budapest

It is only a few hours' drive aboard our private coach from Vienna to the Hungarian capital of Budapest. We'll arrive at midday and after a quick lunch near our hotel, we'll take you on a short orientation tour of the "Pest" side of the Danube River (The "Buda" in Budapest is the area on the western bank of the river, you'll explore that later).

You will see St Stephen's Cathedral, the imposing Hungarian Parliament building, the largest Synagogue in Europe and learn the tragic story of the Holocaust's effect on Hungary. We will point you to the key shopping streets and suggest some restaurants for dinner this evening (Dinner on your own). Budapest is a majestic and well laid-out city, you will have this afternoon and evening to sample it.

Thursday, April 25 Budapest – Free Day

You now have your bearings, so it is time to EXPLORE! There is the wonderful pedestrian shopping street, "Váci Utca" which begins at our hotel and ends at Budapest's famous Great Market Hall. You can cross the Danube on the "Chain Bridge" and take a funicular up to Castle Hill to explore the Buda Side of the river. And don't forget to stop into a wine shop to sample some of Hungary's famous TOKAY wine. If beer is your preference, microbreweries abound in the Synagogue neighborhood. Have a sidewalk café lunch on Franz Liszt Square (Liszt Ferenc), or at the architectural marvel, the New York Café. Dinner tonight on your own and there are so many wonderful eateries to choose from.

Friday, April 26 -Last Day in Budapest

There is still so much to do – take a tour of the Parliament building (Highly recommended), Shop along the upscale Andrássy Avenue, join us for High Tea at the Four Seasons Hotel (Debbie's favorite treat), pamper yourself and your partner with a spa treatment at one of the city's famous natural thermal spas. Tonight, we will host a gala farewell dinner party at a fairytale castle.

Saturday, April 27 – Depart for home.

After breakfast at our hotel, depart for the airport and your home city.
