

1 MS. KRAMER: I never would do that.

2 MR. SCHEUER: I don't -- I don't --

3 MS. KRAMER: Your Honor --

4 MR. SCHEUER: -- want anything --

5 THE COURT: Well, first of all --

6 MR. SCHEUER: -- negative -- I don't want  
7 negative implication to be seen as -- or omission to be  
8 seen as confirmation of something.

9 THE COURT: Well, first of all, you didn't  
10 hear me. That's not what I said.

11 MR. SCHEUER: No. That --

12 THE COURT: I said her perception that it was  
13 voodoo science.

14 MR. SCHEUER: Right.

15 THE COURT: Now, let's back up.

16 Miss Kramer has just finished a lawsuit where  
17 she lost on an issue of defamation. If she walked out  
18 here and chooses -- because only in this room can you  
19 make those kinds of comments back and forth and not run  
20 the risk of defamation. We're here in a court  
21 proceeding. If you go outside and they won in this case  
22 and take out of context what's said here in argument and  
23 the course of my ruling and says it in such a fashion  
24 that it could later be determined to be defamation, then  
25 you're back facing this all over again.
