

Assembly Instructions

1. Print pg. 2 on cardstock.
2. Print pgs. 3-6 on copy paper.
3. Fold the cover (pg. 2) in half.
4. Fold each inside pg. in half with the pictures on the outside.
5. Trim each inside pg. by ¼ in. on each side but the fold edge.
6. When assembled, the cut edge of the pages will go in the spine.
7. Stack the pages in the following order:
 We eat kosher.
 What is kosher?
 Does it chew its cud and have a split hoof?
 It's kosher.
 Does it have fins and scales?
 It's kosher.
 YHVH made many different animals.
 But we eat the kosher ones.
8. Put the pages inside the cover,

again, so the cut edge is in the spine.

9. Put three staples along the edge, you may have to work at it.



10. Enjoy!

My eight year old practices her reading skills by reading it to her younger siblings. It would also make for some lovely informal teaching on Torah living for the little ones. Blessings!

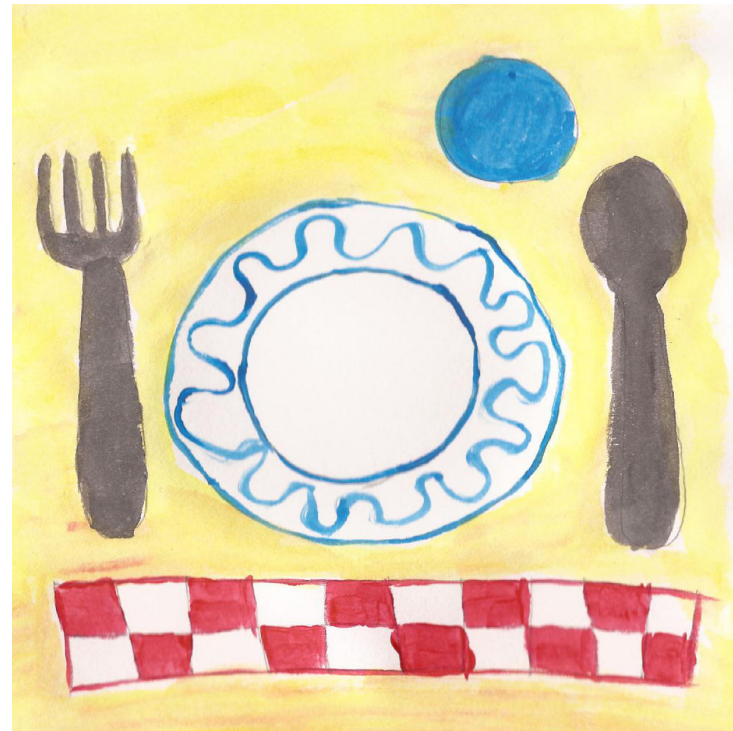

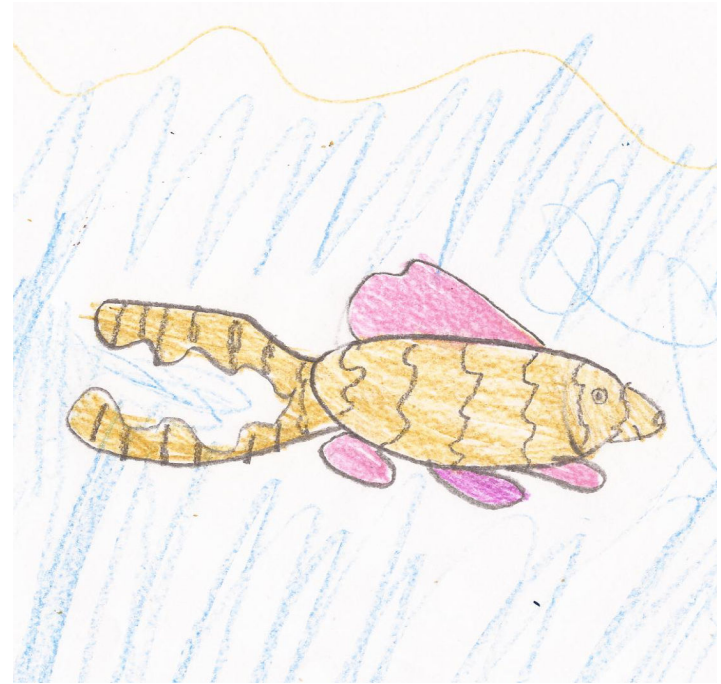
