2 Down, 6 More to GO! Will you partner with us to make camp possible?

It has begun! We have already launched into our summer camping season, and are enjoying every minute of it. For the past 2 weeks we hosted 100 Teenagers and Adults from across North Carolina for Christian Youth in Action. The students were taught how to share the gospel using evangelistic Bible Lessons and Missions Stories in a *5-Day Club*. Over 400 children were reached last week with 40 professions of faith during 'practice' clubs in the Asheville Area as the teens taught under the supervision of CEF staff! Now they are at home preparing for a summer full of *5-Day Club* Ministry.

We are now in the midst of our preparation for children's summer camp. For 6 weeks between July 3 and August 12 the camp will be full of boys and girls ages 7-15 from VA to GA. They will have the opportunity to make friends and memories with all the fun 'only at camp' activities that the week holds. Most importantly, they will be under the teaching of God's Word every day in the form of Bible Songs, Cabin Devotions, Talk Back Sessions, and of course twice daily Chapel. Even our meals in the Mess Hall are bathed in Bible teaching, as counselors will have an opportunity to share a short Spiritual truth after each mealtime called a 'Nugget'. This year, the children will be learning from the Book of Acts about the life of the Apostle Paul each morning, and of the Armor of God and Epistles each evening.

One of the things that children comment on every summer is our great food. We have been blessed with wonderful and creative cooks. Our kitchen volunteers do a great job of making tasty dishes on a very limited budget, and making sure there is always enough for seconds. One week of food at camp costs around \$1,500. One story that breaks the heart is that of a camper shocked to hear the bell ring for lunch. He said to his counselor, "We are already eating again? At home we only eat once a day!"

Please be in prayer for the blessing of our volunteer counselors and staff. They sacrifice their vacation time to feed the children physically and spiritually with the message of the blood of Jesus and it's eternal power.

Our campers come from a variety of backgrounds. We know that many families aren't able to afford a week of camp for their child. This year, as we have for the past 5 years, camp will be tuition free. The cost for one camper to attend for one week is \$160. We work to find ways, big and small, to make every donated dollar stretch as far as possible. Currently we are at 1/3 of our summer budget.
