Rally Bulletin Number 3 – December 2013

Hello and welcome to the Number 3 Bulletin of the 17th Morris Minor National Rally 2015.

- Accommodation** – We have checked the website and accommodation is filling up fast. The message is – book early to avoid any disappointment. Book your accommodation and register early to make sure you get the accommodation you want. Entry numbers are rising and we want to make sure that all entrants get to stay where they would like to.
- Registrations** - We now have over 30 registrations on a first in first served basis and lots of indications from future registrants. We are now in the process of making decisions and we have also completed our bookings for the Victoria side of the Rally venues. We will finalise the NSW side in the next 2 months and the next Bulletin will deal with specific information about venues and a draft program. Again, could club secretaries let us have some idea of approximate numbers of club members in each individual clubs who may be registering for the 2015 17th National Rally. We shall also chase this up via the website and individual contacts so that we can keep track of numbers.
- Proposed runs for the National Rally** – We already have feedback from registrants and proposed registrants and this is to the effect that one size does not fit all! Some people would like a short run, other a slightly longer run and some intrepid souls would like a run to the far end of the North East alps and back again! This Rally we have decided to have 3 proposed runs ie a short run around Albury Wodonga and out to the Bandiana Army Museum, a slightly longer run which would take in Murray River crossings and part of the shore line of Lake Hume and Bethanga Bridge (Albury's version of the Sydney Harbour Bridge) and a longer run for those hardy Rally drivers who would like to see something of North East Victoria including Yackandandah, Mudgegonga and possibly further afield. Number 1 run would not exceed 50km, number 2 run approximately 100 to 120km and number 3 run approximately 200 to 250km. North East Victoria and the border Lake Hume region is a lovely place and we would like to showcase our region for Rally members. However we do need some feedback and

would like Rally registrants to complete the attached form so that we can get some idea of numbers.

4. **Friday night meal** – In original Rally proposals we had decided not to have a Friday night informal meal arranged. We have had some feedback to the affect that this would be a program choice that many would like to see added. Could we please have some feedback so that we can check numbers in plenty of time to do our bookings and make a decision about a Friday night informal meal or otherwise.

5. **Club Sponsorship** – Sorry to keep reminding everyone but we would again ask if individual Morris Minor clubs could consider a request for assistance with sponsorship for trophies or specific events and to let us know over the next 2 or 3 months so that we can start to complete our budget and have some idea of sponsorship assistance from Morris Minor clubs Australia wide for 2014/15 budget purposes.

Once again thank you to all those who have registered early and expressed support. There will be further Rally bulletins at about 2 to 3 month intervals with more detail including bookings and feedback about the survey.

Look forward to seeing you all at the 17th National Morris Minor Rally.
