Snowfall, Salvation, and the First Supper

In just the last month we have seen over 18 inches of snow here at camp, and winter is just beginning! The snowfall forced us to postpone the teen boys retreat for several days, but God's plan is ALWAYS better than ours. Several of the boys who came would not have been able to attend had the retreat been on the scheduled dates, and perhaps *those* were the young men that God wanted to deal with.

Our girls retreat was the most well attended yet, with 28 young ladies present, and the boys retreat hosted 16. The Chapel times centered on the Book of Jonah. Many of the campers were reading about his minor prophet with a major problem for the first time, and were eager for the next session when they would find out how God dealt with this disobedient servant. Again and again the campers would approach counselors during free time with questions about spiritual things, and for counsel on how to deal with the challenges they face every day at school and home. We can't thank our Heavenly Father enough for providing us with such wonderful volunteers who gave up their holiday vacations to serve.

The last day of our boys retreat fell on Sunday morning, so Dennis set up the chapel for a worship service centered around the Lord's Table. The young men were encouraged sing the hymns and to partake of the bread and cup if they had professed Christ as their Savior. Several of the boys who have come to know the Lord here at camp in previous summers told us afterwards that this was their first time celebrating the Lord's Supper. What an honor to be able to introduce the boys to this wonderful remembrance of our Redeemer!

The Saturday Night Alive ministry is continuing strong, with new teens each month, and visible fruit from the work!

In addition to the weekly Bible clubs here at camp, Nick and local CEF Director Jason Beverly taught 18 Christmas Party Clubs this December across 2 counties, and around 325 children heard the Gospel message. Praise the Lord for the salvation that we were able to witness of Troy, an eight year old who believed in Christ because of this ministry. God *is* working, and what an privilege to be used by Him as he does. 🍷

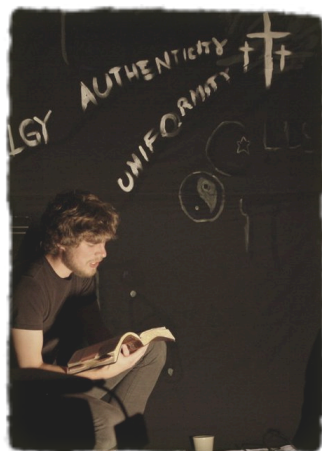
