## Stuffed Candy Canes

Free Pattern by Cindy Markovcy © 2008 Homespun from the Heart

Supplies Needed: Scraps of fabric, any kind Fiberfill stuffing Matching thread and needle Tea stain



I've included 2 sizes of candy canes - I like to make both sizes and sell them as bowl fillers, ornaments (as shown) or even make some for my dolls to hold.

For best results, print or copy your pattern pieces onto cardstock and cut out to make templates.

Trace the shapes onto the wrong side of doubled fabric. Sew on the traced line, leaving openings as indicated on pattern pieces Turn RSO and stuff each piece firmly; whipstitch the openings closed with color matching thread.

If you wish, mix 1/4 cup of tea stain with 1/2 cup of water and brush everything down with the mixture and a sponge brush. Allow to dry completely.

If you don't have access to fun fabrics, you can also make these out of muslin and then paint the stripes on the finished piece.
