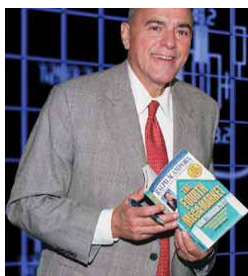
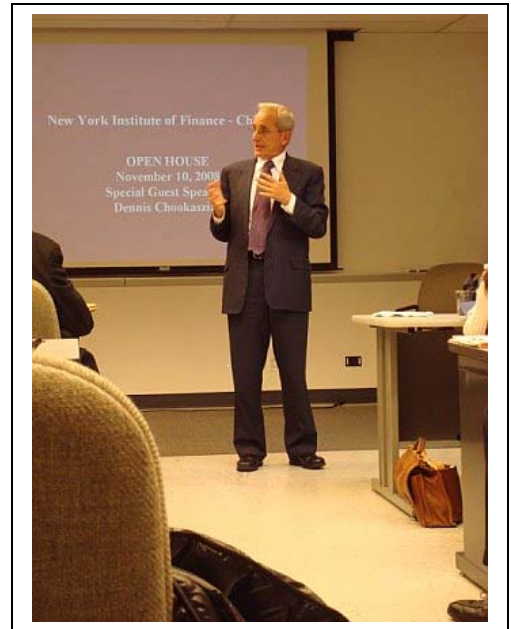

Chicago Open House a Huge Success!

Chicago, Illinois – World financial markets are likely to worsen over the next several months, according to Financial Accounting Standards Advisory Council Chairman Dennis Chookaszian. Speaking at the Open House of the New York Institute of Finance-Chicago, Mr. Chookaszian warned of adverse consequences to financial markets if global accounting standards do not reflect economic reality. “Mark to market accounting should not be replaced by ‘mark to myth’ accounting,” Chookaszian said. He also said that the credit crisis is not likely to abate until more transparency is achieved

in accounting for financial instruments, particularly exotic derivatives such as credit default swaps. “No one knows what these instruments are really worth,” he said. “These contracts need to be exchange traded so that we can determine a fair value for them. Once a value is established, then the financial markets might become stabilized.” Chookaszian also criticized politicians and pundits who appear on TV financial broadcasts and blame the financial crisis on accounting standards. “That is like shooting the messenger,” he explained.
