## THE PREMIUM WINE COLLECTION

### The Connoisseurs Collection \$395.00

**Champagne Delamotte Brut, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, France | ①**  
Champagne Delamotte's classic Brut Non-Vintage shows the sheer class and elegance of this small, old established Champagne house, based in the heart of top Grand Cru village Le Mesnil-sur-Oger. Extended ageing on the lees gives this Champagne its unique blend of freshness, balance and depth.

**Olivier Leflaive, Montagny Bonneveaux, 1er Cru, Burgundy, France | ①**  
The Leflaive family has a long history of quality wine-making in Burgundy, to which Olivier has added a new dimension. Bright lemon in colour with flashes of green. Fresh stone fruits with hints of ginger on the nose. The wine has a great minerality balanced with plenty of concentrated, creamy fruit on the palate.

**St. Supéry, Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley, USA | ①**  
A superb Sauvignon Blanc, unusually fresh and aromatic, owing to the higher elevation of the Dollarhide vineyards. Very ripe tropical nose with guava and pink grapefruit. The palate is full, rich and broad textured, yet also has a crystalline purity and surprising freshness. Very long on the finish which develops preserved lemon and candied lime flavours.

### The Premier Collection \$325.00

**Muddy Water, Chardonnay, Waipara, New Zealand | ②**  
This is a complex and intense New Zealand Chardonnay with a silky texture and long finish. Almonds, butterscotch and rich stone fruits all balanced by a beautifully fresh acidity. The team of Muddy Water winery have a deliberate hands off policy in the winery, preferring to let nature take its course and the wine show its true expression.

**Gran Lurton, Corte Friulano, Mendoza, Argentina | ②**  
This is a truly exceptional wine, boasting a perfect balance of weight and elegance. The wine exudes ripe, tropical notes of apricot and vanilla, while all the while remaining fresh and elegant with a light, citrus finish. A blend of Sauvignon Vert (Friulano), Pinot Gris, Chardonnay and Torrontes gives the wine the unique flavour and distinction it deserves.

**Clos Poggiale Blanc, Skalli, Corsica, France | ①**  
This is truly a handcrafted wine that showcases the superb quality available on the island of Corsica. Straw coloured with a beautiful, powerful nose, full of minerals, lemon, pear and tangerine. The palate is rich and creamy textured, but with noticeable freshness and flavours of citrus fruits and blossom. Long and finely poised.

**PSI, Dominio de Pingus, Peter Sisseck, Ribera del Duero, Spain | ⑤**  
From the prestigious Spanish region of Ribera del Duero, the nose unusually evokes fresh grape must allied to cherries, plums and fresh blueberry, all complemented by pronounced mineral notes. The palate is supple and accessible, plump and ripe, supported by rounded tannins which, with the minerality, give tremendous focus and direction.

**d'Arenberg, The Coppermine Road, Cabernet Sauvignon, McLaren Vale, Australia | ⑤**  
One of the icon wines produced by Chester Osborne from old vines in McLaren Vale, this wine features dense, rich berry fruit aromas and flavours with a ripe, fine-grained tannic structure.

**Brunello di Montalcino, Castello Banfi, Tuscany, Italy | ⑤**  
The most aristocratic combination of Montalcino tradition with winemaking modernity. Complex with sweet but delicate notes of jam, well integrated plum and dark cherry as well as some attractive liquorice, tobacco and leather notes. Powerful and persistent structure with a nice mixture of soft and sweet tannins.

**Moss Wood, 'Amy's Blend', Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Malbec and Merlot, Margaret River, Australia | ⑤**  
Moss Wood is a premium wine producer located in the Margaret River Wine region of Western Australia. Full of mulberry and redcurrant aromas, there are background notes of oak, eucalyptus and capsicum. The palate is generous, juicy and quite full bodied. The finish is long and shows fine, ripe tannins.

**Les Allées de Cantemerle, 2nd wine of Château Cantemerle, Saint-Julien, France | ⑤**  
One of the prettiest estates in the Médoc! Deep ruby colour with hints of brick. The nose shows black cherry, cassis and cigar box aromas. The palate is medium bodied, well rounded and supple, with red and black fruits, a little spice and soft tannins.

**Bodegas Zugoer, Belezos, Reserva Rioja, Spain | ⑤**  
Classic Rioja. Supple, ripe but elegant style, true to Rioja traditions but with modern fruit appeal. Rich plum and dark cherry fruit spiked with just enough warm spice, the flavours linger for a long finish. Fresh balancing acidity and ripe tannin structure.

### The New World Collection \$260.00

**Urlar, Sauvignon Blanc, Gladstone, New Zealand | ①**  
A really elegant and surprisingly restrained style of New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc. This multi-dimensional wine delivers zesty gooseberry, capsicum and lime flavours with a hint of passionfruit. While it remains a distinctively New Zealand sauvignon blanc the palate is full with great weight and length.

**Knapstein, Hand Picked Riesling, Clare Valley, Australia | ①**  
A wonderful example of intense, pure Clare Valley Riesling. The Knapstein Hand Picked Riesling shows lifted citrus aromas with distinct notes of slate and spice. The palate displays the classic Watervale characters of lemon and lime with a fine mineral structure. The natural acid level provides the wine's backbone and palate line and is perfectly balanced.

**Napa Cellars, Chardonnay, Napa Valley, USA | ①**  
Rich, buttery, spicy and toasty, this Chardonnay boasts beautiful aromas that conjure scents of home-baked apple crisp. The flavours are lush with ripe pear, apple and a touch of tropical pineapple and guava. The wine is delicately balanced with a long and sweet toffee finish.

### The French Collection \$285.00

**Cave de Cléebourg, Pinot Blanc-Auxerrois, Alsace | ③**  
This curious cousin of Pinot Blanc is known as Auxerrois, specifically in Cléebourg, Northern Alsace. With smaller yields than its more famous relative, the Cléebourg Pinot Blanc is more precocious, producing wine that is light-bodied and fruity with notes of fresh herbs on the finish.

**Clos du Pressoir, Vignobles Joseph Mellot, Menetou-Salon, Loire Valley | ①**  
Bijou and hand-made single vineyard Sauvignon Blanc from the Loire's rising star appellation: Menetou-Salon. This wine is herbaceous with grapefruit notes and a creamy, crushed seashell minerality. Think lemon meringue pie!

**Olivier Leflaive, Pernand-Vergelesses, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy | ①**  
Often called 'Poor Man's Corton', this Pernand-Vergelesses from Olivier Leflaive exudes class and poise. Limestone soils here give a wine with a taut, mineral character. Olivier Leflaive's offering is tangy and linear with notes of green apples and a light creaminess.

**Amancaya, Malbec/Cabernet Sauvignon, Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite) and Nicolas Catena, Mendoza, Argentina | ⑤**  
This wine is from Lafite Rothschild in Mendoza and is powerful and smooth. Amancaya, as its elder sibling "CARO", presents a harmonious balance between the Argentine and Bordeaux styles. A more fruity style coming from the higher percentage of Malbec and shorter ageing. Aromas of blackcurrant and plums with a hint of vanilla and mocha.

**Ironstone, 'Old Vine' Zinfandel, Lodi, Sierra Foothills, USA | ⑤**  
This medium-bodied Zinfandel has exceptional varietal character with lovely aromas of dark fruit and blackberry. Subtle pepper spice mingles with richly concentrated fruit flavors of blackberry, ripe plums and fresh red raspberries.

**Moss Wood, 'Amy's Blend', Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Malbec and Merlot, Margaret River, Australia | ⑤**  
Moss Wood is a premium wine producer located in the Margaret River Wine region of Western Australia. Full of mulberry and redcurrant aromas, there are background notes of oak, eucalyptus and capsicum. The palate is generous, juicy and quite full bodied. The finish is long and shows fine, ripe tannins.

**Clos Poggiale Rouge, Skalli, Corsica | ⑤**  
This is truly a handcrafted wine that showcases the superb quality available on the island of Corsica. Deep ruby coloured with brick tints. The nose is powerful and fruity, with notes of raspberry liqueur and caramel. The palate is rich and chocolaty, with dark cherry, framboise, spice and very silky tannins.

**Maison Roche de Bellene, Nicholas Potel, Givry, Côte Chalonnaise, Burgundy | ⑤**  
Most of the wines here are from organic grapes and there are no additions in the winery. The Givry is 100% Pinot Noir. Plum coloured nose of dark berries, with some earthy and spicy notes. The palate is medium bodied, with good intensity of fruit and fine tannins.

**Blason de Ausières, Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite), Corbières | ⑤**  
Blason d'Ausières is a selection characterised by its fruit maturity, freshness, supple and fleshy texture which reflect the terroir of the estate. Its aromas remind us of the rich garrigue and spicy flavours. 20% of the wine is aged in oak barrels for 12 months.





## THE CLASSIC WINE COLLECTION

### The White Wine Collection \$230.00

#### Château Bonnet, Entre-Deux-Mers, France | ①

The 'Entre-Deux-Mers' region of Bordeaux is well-known for its crisp dry whites made from Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon grapes. Refreshing lemon aromas and some riper flavours of grapefruit and passionfruit. Fresh, but rich, with great balance.

#### Nelson Estate, Sauvignon Blanc, Paarl, South Africa | ①

Lisha Nelson is the new winemaker at her father's estate. 2008 was her first vintage and this Sauvignon Blanc scooped the coveted Gold Medal at the Michaelangelo International Wine Awards. Green peppers blend with greengage and yellow plums, lifted by a refreshing acidity.

#### Pyramid Hill, Semillon, Hunter Valley, Australia | ②

The nose shows fresh, limey fruit with creamy baked apples and honey developing in time. The palate offers bright pink grapefruit and citrus flavours. The characteristic freshness and acidity of remains present at all stages of the wine's development.

#### La Prendina, Pinot Bianco, Lake Garda, Italy | ①

The Pinot Bianco is very typical of the area, with a subdued nose of cooking apples and blossom. The palate has some weight and spiciness and a creamy texture.

#### Napa Cellars, Chardonnay, Napa Valley, USA | ①

Rich, buttery, spicy and toasty, this Chardonnay boasts beautiful aromas that conjure scents of home-baked apple crisp. The flavours are lush with ripe pear, apple and a touch of tropical pineapple and guava. The wine is delicately balanced with a long and sweet toffee finish.

#### Valdivieso, Viognier Reserva, Central Valley, Chile | ②

Intense fruity aromas of ripe apricots, pears and subtle sweet spices whilst the palate is full of exotic fruits. Three months in oak barrels gives complexity while maintaining its fruit-dominant character.

### The Red Wine Collection: \$230.00

#### Mapu Reserva, Carmenère, Baron Philippe de Rothschild, Maipo Valley, Chile | ③

MAPU means 'earth' in the language of the Mapuche 'people of the earth', the native people of Chile. This wine has rich aromas of cherry and blackberry, with notes of spice and roasted coffee. Palate is packed with black fruits, mocha and chocolate.

#### Château Moureau, Minervois, France | ①

Steeped in history, Château Moureau is one of the oldest wineries in the Languedoc. A beautifully balanced red, with plenty of fresh, berry fruit and savoury spice. Classically structured with an ideal balance of dusty herbs and fresh plum.

#### Castillo de Clavijo, Crianza, Rioja, Spain | ③

Produced by Bodegas Criadores de Rioja, a Bodega which typifies 21st century Rioja in its careful balancing of tradition and innovation. Aged for 12 to 18 months in American & French oak casks. The fruit is balanced with vanilla and spice to add richness and body.

#### Palestra Tinto, Dão Sul, Quinta de Sa de Baixo Douro, Portugal | ⑤

On the nose this wine is full of ripe black fruits, notably mulberry and blackberry, with warm and spicy overtones. The palate is medium to full bodied, richly fruited yet surprisingly elegant and supple. The finish is warm and spicy, with gentle ripe tannins.

#### Septima, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina | ⑤

Septima Malbec is a beautiful red wine from the esteemed Uco Valley of Argentina. This wine has an intense rich colour. The nose has hints of blackcurrant fruit with well integrated oak. A concentrated wine with elegant soft tannins. Well balanced with persistent length on the end palate.

#### Ironstone, 'Old Vine' Zinfandel, Lodi, Sierra Foothills, USA | ⑤

This medium-bodied Zinfandel has exceptional varietal character with lovely aromas of dark fruit and blackberry. Subtle pepper spice mingles with richly concentrated fruit flavours of blackberry, ripe plums and fresh red raspberries.

#### Château d'Astros, Côtes de Provence, France | ①

This Domaine has been doing what it does best now for over 200 years – which is to make great Rosé. This is typical Provençal wine, pale pink in colour with refreshing juicy strawberry and raspberry flavours.

#### Louis Bernard, Tavel, Rhône, France | ①

One of the great appellations of the Southern Rhone, Tavel was a favourite of Louis XIV in the 18th century. Made from Grenache and Cinsault, it is dry in style and matches a wide range of foods.

#### Via Nova, Pinot Grigio, Blush, Veneto, Italy | ①

Salmon pink in colour with an aromatic nose of freshly crushed cranberries and mineral elements. The palate is light, dry and crisp, with a delicious balance between zingy citrus and fruity red berry flavours. Very easy to drink, finishing clean and refreshing.

#### Cunard Private Label, Syrah, Settesoli, Sicily, Italy | ②

On the nose this wine displays aromas of sweet raspberries and strawberries with delicate floral notes. The palate is lively, bursting with crisp red berry flavours and a good persistent finish.

#### Delicato Family Vineyards, White Zinfandel, Napa valley, USA | ③

Vibrant pink in colour this is a medium, fresh, juicy Rosé that seems full of Californian sunshine.

#### Cunard Private Label, Chardonnay, Settesoli, Sicily, Italy | ①

Rich, ripe green apple aromas with some hints of macadamia nuts and honey. Soft and rich, ripe, fruity palate, leading to a long, rounded finish.

#### Cunard Private Label, Pinot Grigio, Settesoli, Sicily, Italy | ①

Bursting with tropical fruit flavours, this wine is fresh and lively with a long, dry finish. It has more body than most Pinot Grigios from the North of Italy, making it ideal with food.

#### Cunard Private Label, Sauvignon Blanc, Settesoli, Sicily, Italy | ②

Brilliant, satisfyingly intense yellow with green highlights. Peach and passion fruit blossom with spicy warmth and a full body.

On the nose this wine displays aromas of sweet raspberries and strawberries with delicate floral notes. The palate is lively bursting with crisp red berry flavours and a good persistent finish.

#### Château Bonnet, Entre-Deux-Mers, France | ①

This Domaine has been doing what it does best now for over 200 years – which is to make great Rosé. This is typical Provençal wine, pale pink in colour with refreshing juicy strawberry and raspberry flavours.

#### Château Cadet, Côtes de Castillon, Bordeaux, France | ⑤

#### A20, Bodegas Castro Martin, Albariño, Sobre Lias, Rias Baixas, Spain | ①

This is delicate and refreshing Albariño with mouth watering tropical fruit and citrus flavours, the finish is long and ripe, with plenty of finesse and expression.

#### Gran Lurton, Corte Friulano, Mendoza, Argentina | ①

The top white from Lurton is a tribute to the great white wines made from the Friulano grape variety in Italy. This blend of Friulano, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay and Torrontes manages to capture their combination of refreshing crispness and subtle fruit flavours admirably.

#### Château de Callac, Pessac – Léognan (Graves), France | ②

Chateau de Callac is located on the highest points of the town of Illats South East of Bordeaux. Young and lively on the nose with wild berry overtones. The nose is confirmed by the palate. Good structure with excellent balance of alcohol and tannin.

#### Bodegas Zugober, Belezos, Reserva, Rioja, Spain | ⑤

Classic Rioja. Supple, ripe but elegant style, true to Rioja traditions but with modern fruit appeal. Rich plum and dark cherry fruit spiked with just enough warm spice, the flavours linger for a long finish. Fresh balancing acidity and ripe tannin structure.

#### Warwick Estate, Pinotage, Stellenbosch, South Africa | ⑤

Owned by the Ratcliffe family since 1964. The aromas show ripe cassis, cedar wood and dark chocolate. Full bodied with rich concentrated fruit, and good length.

#### A to Z Wineworks, Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley (Oregon), USA | ②

A to Z is one of the rising stars in Oregon. Light in colour, with some spice on the nose with aromas of blueberries, cherries and white pepper - super silky on the palate.

#### Blason de Ausières, Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite), Corbières, France | ②

Blason d'Ausières is a selection characterised by its fruit maturity, freshness, supple and fleshy texture, which reflect the terroir of the estate. Its aromas remind us of the rich garrigue and spicy flavours. 20% of the wine is aged in oak barrels for 12 months.

#### Maison Roche de Bellene, Nicholas Potel, Givry, Burgundy, France | ③

Most of the wines here are from organic grapes and there are no additions in the winery. The nose shows dark berries, notably raspberry and cherry, with some earthy and spicy notes. The palate is medium bodied, with good intensity of fruit and fine tannins.

#### Valdivieso Éclat, Mourvèdre, Carignan & Syrah, Central Valley, Chile | ②

This Rhone-style blend is sourced from old vineyards in the Maule Valley and features complex spice and dark fruit aromas and flavours.
